The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they are running the business of commission agents in partnership with each other in New Grain Mandi at Ambala City. They were getting repeated threats from respondents No.5 and 6, who often entered the shop of the petitioners forcibly and demanded money from them by extending threats to them.

Reply has been filed by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Ambala on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. It has been stated in the

said affidavit that appropriate instructions have been issued to SHO, Police Station, Ambala City and In-charge Police Post No.5 to keep vigil at the shop of the petitioners for timely patrolling in the area for the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners. Learned State counsel further submits that in case, any complaint is received with regard to the threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that she is satisfied with the assurance given by the learned State counsel and the petition is disposed of in view of the statement made by learned State counsel.
