SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (Oral)

1. The learned State counsel on instructions imparted to him by the concerned does not oppose the prayer made in the writ petition, that a mandamus be made upon the Tehsildar of the Illaqa concerned, to make demarcation of the disputed lands.
2. The said demarcation shall be made by the empowered revenue officer but within three weeks from today. Subsequently, if any encroachments are revealed to be made therein by the encroachers on the *Gair Mumkin Chappar*, thereupon, the BDPO concerned is directed to forthwith institute a petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 before the Collector concerned, who shall on receiving the same shall proceed to most expeditiously draw a speaking decision thereons, but after hearing all affected persons concerned.
3. Disposed of.
