The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.1 to make the payment to the petitioners of the admitted amount due to the petitioners from the amount payable by the respondent No.1 to Ludhiana Talwandi Toll Roads Private Limited (earlier known as Essel India Ludhiana Talwandi Toll Roads Private Limited) and a further prayer to decide the representations dated 20.01.2020 & 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-10) and 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-12).

It is not in dispute that the petitioner had entered into an agreement with Ludhiana Talwandi Toll Roads Private Limited (earlier known as Essel India Ludhiana Talwandi Toll Roads Private Limited) for the carrying out EPC Contract PAN India. Apparently, there is no preivity of contract between the petitioner and respondent No.1-

National Highway Authority of India.

Counsel for the petitioner thus does not press the instant petition at this stage so as to take recourse to the remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Disposed of as not pressed with liberty as aforesaid.
