1. The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the grant of interim bail to the petitioner in FIR No.376 dated 13.05.2019, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 302, 120-B, 34 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Palwal, Haryana for a period of 20 days on the ground that the daughter of the petitioner is to get married on 23.11.2023.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that although the petitioner is involved in number of other cases but earlier in the year 2020, he was granted interim bail and he surrendered well in time and as on today, the total custody of the petitioner is about 4 years and 3 months. He further submitted that due to the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner and for

performing necessary ceremonies, he may be considered for the grant of interim bail.

3. On the other hand, Mr. Naveen Kumar Sheoran, DAG, Haryana submitted that in pursuance of the order passed by this Court on 17.11.2023 to ascertain the factual position as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner, he has verified from the concerned Investigating Officer that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is scheduled to be held on 23.11.2023. He further submitted that as per the Investigating Officer there is no such apprehension that in case the petitioner is released on interim bail then he may abscond or may not surrender back.

4. In view of the aforesaid position, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that the petitioner shall be released on interim bail for a period of 20 days with effect from 22.11.2023, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

5. It is made clear that on the expiry of aforesaid 20 days, the petitioner shall immediately surrender before the jail authorities.
