The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.506 dated 04.11.2022 under Sections 379, 411 IPC and Sections 2, 41 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 and Sections 49, 49A, 51A of the Wildlife Protect Act, 1972 (added later on) as well as Section 120-B IPC (added later on) registered at Police sTation Naraingarh, District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.01.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Sultan Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 09.01.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.01.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
