SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana does not oppose the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail the statutorily prescribed remedy, as comprised in the petitioner, making an appeal against the impugned annexure.
