1. By way of present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner is seeking direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect his life and liberty.

2. On 19.12.2022, following order was passed:-

*“On request of the learned counsel for the petitioner,
adjourned to 27.01.2023”*

3. Again, on 27.01.2023, following order was passed:-

*“Even on second call, there is no representation on behalf
of counsel for the petitioner.*

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 08.02.2023.”

4. Today, counsel appearing for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of present petition with liberty to seek recourse to the alternative remedy, as available to him under the law.

5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty, as aforementioned.
