The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.299 dated 07.10.2017 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh as well as the order dated 17.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chandigarh titled as State Vs. Jasbir Singh, whereby the Courts below have declared the petitioner as a proclaimed offender.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that initially, the FIR had been quashed on the basis of a compromise vide order dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P-2). However, as the petitioner had not complied with the said order, the FIR came to be revived. He states that now in compliance of the order dated 09.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), a sum of Rs.6000/- and Rs.4000/- has been deposited with the appropriate authorities as mentioned in the said order.

The said fact has not been denied by the learned counsel for the U.T., Chandigarh.

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In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the FIR No.299 dated 07.10.2017 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sector 11, Chandigarh as well as the order dated 17.11.2022 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Chandigarh and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom stands quashed.
