HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the parties agree that keeping in view the administrative decision already taken on 30.01.2023, all the candidates irrespective of the fact that from where they have passed 10+2 examination, have been made eligible and the petitioners had already been treated eligible and have also been appointed.

2. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners were offered appointment at a particular District initially but now, they have been appointed in another District, which is causing prejudice to the petitioners.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing appropriate representation that in case the District which was offered to

them initially, are lying vacant, they should be accommodated on the same District so that the petitioners do not suffer any prejudice.

4. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioners raising the said claim, the same will be considered with open mind and appropriate order will be passed within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case the claim of the petitioners is found tenable, appropriate relief will also be extended to them within a period of further four weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, with liberty as prayed for.
