1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 1 to 4 to protect the petitioner and his family members from the illegal threatening and harassment being caused by the respondent Nos. 5 to 10 and the local police officials.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a representation was given on 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the police authorities, however, it had failed to yield any response. It has been submitted that the official respondents were under a legal obligation to pass an appropriate order on his complaint.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. On asking of the Court, Ms. Kanica Sachdeva, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.4- Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, is directed to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.4 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the

representation dated 03.10.2023 (Annexure P-3), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.
