SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.503 dated 20.09.2022 under Sections 406, 420 IPC registered at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and it was the other co-accused on whose demand of Rs.8,90,000/- was transferred and the petitioner is, therefore, not the beneficiary.

Considering the aforesaid assertions, the petitioner has granted the concession of interim protection on 09.01.2023 while issuing notice of motion he was released on bail subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer.

On the last date of hearing dated 27.02.2023, the petitioner contended that due to ailment of the father of the petitioner he could not join

the investigation and subsequently sought time and last opportunity was granted to join the investigation within a period of 15 days on the condition as mentioned in order 09.01.2023.

Today again the same is identical, learned State counsel has apprise this Court despite one last opportunity was granted by this Court on the last date of hearing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has forwarded necessary instructions to his client who is not in a position to defend the instant petition any further, therefore, he do not want to press the same.

In the light of the aforesaid fact, the petitioner does not seem interested and, therefore, petition is dismissed.
