1. Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that keeping in view the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in **CWP No. 2371 of 2010** titled **Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab**, decided on 31.08.2010, which judgment has already attained finality, the petitioners are entitled for the benefit under the Old Pension Scheme which benefit has not been extended to the petitioners and that too without any valid justification.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already raised a grievance through the representation dated 07.07.2023 and 10.01.2023, copy of which have been appended as Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively, and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case time bound direction is given to the respondent by this Court to pass an appropriate speaking order.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Pankaj Middha, Addl. AG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in case, representations dated 07.07.2023 and 10.01.2023 have been received in the office of the concerned authority and the same are still pending consideration, appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of the copy of this order and in case, any benefit is to be allowed to the petitioners as per the speaking order, the same will also be released within further period of 4 weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

6. Ordered accordingly.
