RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (Oral)

Present writ petition has been filed for directing respondent No.3 to make appropriate arrangements for exhaust of the sewerage of village Meharban and other areas attached with it by allowing the sewerage connection of village Meharban with the sewerage inlet (Main Gutter) of the Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana at the appropriate places on the boundary of the village Meharban and Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana so that the sewerage water may be disposed of properly and the public health of the villagers may be duly protected which is in grave danger due to the inappropriate disposal of the sewerage water.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted before this Court that for the redressal of their grievances, the petitioners have already filed a representation (Annexure P-4) before the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana but no action has been taken on the same till date. He submits

that as the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana is not a party in the present petition so the petitioners be granted the liberty to file their representation before respondent No.3 i.e. the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Ludhiana and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab and Mr. Harpreet Singh Gharuan, Advocate appear and accept the notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 and respondent No.3 respectively. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 has stated that in case representation as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners is filed, then respondent No.3 will decide the same as per law.

Heard.

In view of the above position, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to the petitioners file their appropriate representation before respondent No.3 as prayed for within a period of 07 days from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioners within the stipulated period, then respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner, Municipal Commissioner, Ludhiana is directed to hear the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of its filing.
