1. Challenge in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is to securitization proceedings and the sale notice dated 05.12.2022 (Annexure P-5) wherein, a sum of Rs.11,35,475/- which was due on 18.01.2018 was sought to be recovered by resorting to the sale of the mortgaged property.

2. On 20.03.2023, the following order was passed:-

behalf of counsel for the petitioner.*

*Mr. Goel prays for time to find out as to whether
the matter has been settled since the amount advanced
