Present petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking anticipatory bail in a case bearing FIR No.240 dated 20.05.2022 under Sections 17-B/61/85 of the NDPS Act and Sections 332/353/186/193/120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

Vide order dated 20.12.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 20.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Shekhar Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 31.01.2023 and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 20.12.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
