DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This is the second petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.141 dated 23.09.2022 registered under Sections 324 and 34 of IPC (later on added Section 326 of IPC vide Rapat No.033 dated 03.10.2022) at Police Station Kote Ise Khan, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that as per the directions of this Court, the petitioner has joined investigation and he is no more required for further investigation in the present case. It has also been contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Resham Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation. He further submits that Dattar has also been recovered from the petitioner.

In view of the facts that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for further custodial interrogation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 04.01.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
