The present petition has been filed seeking quashing of order dated 19.10.2022 vide which application of the petitioner for temporary parole to perform last rites and rituals of his brother who had expired on 16.09.2022, has been rejected by respondent No.2.

Since the authority had denied temporary parole rightly or wrongly because of which the petitioner seeks parole, has now become redundant. Needless to say that after more than 3 months, no rites and rituals are remain to be performed for which the presence of the petitioner is required.

However, it is clarified that in case any of the family members of the petitioner want to meet him in the Jail, they shall be accommodated by the concerned Jail Superintendent and given enough time to meet each other.

Given above, in the entirety of facts and circumstance of this case, the present petition is dismissed. All pending application(s), if any, stand disposed of.
