In compliance of the last order, the alleged *detenue*, namely, Shasta has been produced in the Court.

During the course of proceedings, I have interacted with her and she submits that she is major and wants to stay with her husband, namely, Narveer, brother of the petitioner. Even, Narveer is also present in the Court and has produced the copy of the order dated 14.02.2023 passed by the High Court of Himachal Pradesh, Shimla, whereby, he has been granted the concession of bail. The copy of the said order is taken on record.

Since the alleged *detenue* is major and wants to stay in the matrimonial home with her husband. She is permitted to go with Narveer brother of the petitioner/her husband.

No further orders are required and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
