The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.111 dated 08.10.2022 registered under Section 304-A IPC (Section 304 IPC added later on), Section 15 of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 at Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 21.12.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 21.12.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
