By way of present petition, the petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.165 dated 09.08.2022 under Sections 323, 506 and 34 of IPC, 1860 with Sections 307 and 325 IPC, 1860, added later during the investigation registered at Police Station Bhattu Kalan, Fatehabad, Haryana.

Referring to the FIR, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the injury under Section 307 IPC, has not been attributed to the petitioner. He further submits that the petitioner is already behind the bars since 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2022 and *challan* already stands filed. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the trial is likely to take long time and as such, petitioner may be released on bail during its pendency.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State opposes the grant of regular bail to the petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 31<sup>st</sup> August, 2022. Trial is unlikely to conclude any time soon. Therefore, no useful purpose would be

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it may prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
