The present contempt petition has been filed with a prayer that the respondents have intentionally and willfully disobeyed the order passed by this Court in CWP No. 26497 of 2022 dated 29.08.2023.

Learned counsel for the submits that petitioners submits that the respondents were under obligation to refund the amount along with interest within a period of one month which direction the respondents have not complied with making them liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
