ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner alleges violation of the order dated 23.07.2009, vide which a direction was issued to stay the renewal of permits to auto rickshaws and public transport buses (city buses) running on diesel within the Municipal Corporation limits of three cities i.e. Ludhiana, Jalandhar and Amritsar as well as the subsequent order dated 15.03.2010, vide which in partial modification, it was directed that renewal of permits and registration of vehicles shall proceed and if the vehicle is already purchased and registered, then it will be allowed to ply untill further orders.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in violation of the aforesaid orders, the respondents have renewed the permits of the outdated vehicles.

Affidavit of Secretary, Regional Transport Authority, Ludhiana along with an order dated 24.02.2023 (Annexure R-1 colly.), filed in the Court today, is taken on record and in the said order, it is stated that renewal of permit of diesel auto rickshaw in question is withdrawn and its permit is cancelled.

In view of the above, this petition is rendered as infructuous at this stage, with liberty to revive the same, if any further violation is found.

Liberty is also granted to the petitioner to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so required.
