JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to provide complete record pertaining to travel history of Supinder Singh son of Tarlochan Singh (husband of the petitioner).

2. The petitioner has been implicated in FIR No. 126 dated 16.06.2018 under Sections 306, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Matour, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) alleging that she had abetted her husband to commit suicide. The petitioner claims that Supinder Singh is still alive and he is staying with another lady. The petitioner is claiming that if travel history of Supinder Singh is collected, it would prove that he is still alive.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-Union of India, on instructions from Bureau of Immigration, submits that as per their record, Supinder Singh departed from Chandigarh Airport on 24.06.2017 and came back to India on

27.06.2017. The FIR was registered on 16.06.2018 and as per their record, Supinder Singh has not traveled after 27.06.2017.

4. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the present petition, however, prays that State Authorities may be directed to look into documents submitted by the petitioner.

5. In the wake of statements of both sides, the instant petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to approach police authorities. This Court is sanguine of the fact that if petitioner submits some concrete documents with respect to status of Supinder Singh, the Investigating Officer would look into the same.
