On 21.12.2022, the following order was passed:-

“The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.PC for quashing of FIR No.540 dated 26.06.2016 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 341 and 506 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on) registered at Police Station Thanesar City, Kurukshetra.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that between the year 2016 to 2022 the petitioner was staying at Singapore and was unaware of the present proceedings and came to be declared as proclaimed person on 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-7). He contends that he came back to India in 2022 and was made aware of the present proceedings. He is ready and willing to join the same.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the Trial court within a period of one week from today subject to his depositing Rs.2,00,000/- (rupees two lacs) as cost. However, the said amount shall be deposited in equal shares i.e.

Rs.50,000/- each with Day Care Centre for Elderly Disabled Home for Old and Destitute People, Sector 15, Chandigarh, Senior Citizen Home, Udyog Path, Sector 15-D, Chandigarh, Spinal Rehab Centre Plot No.1, Madhya Marg, Sector 28-A, Chandigarh and Institute for Blind, Sector 26, Chandigarh. On his doing so he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

In reference to the aforementioned order, the petitioner has been granted the concession of interim bail by the Court of Duty/Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Kurukshetra vide order dated 27.12.2022 The copy of the said order is marked as X.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

However, the petitioner is directed to surrender his passport before the Trial Court immediately.
