The petitioner has filed the present petition before this Court with a prayer to direct the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members as she apprehends threat at the hands of private respondents.

A status report by way of an affidavit of Inspector/SHO Police Station Moonak has been filed on behalf of the State of Haryana. The learned State counsel contends that petitioner Nirmala Devi had moved a complaint to the DGP, Haryana, on 01.12.2022 and the said complaint was marked to the Station House Officer, Moonak. He further contends that one FIR No. 7 dated 11.01.2023 under Sections 447/506/120-B/34 IPC has been registered at Police Station Moonak on the basis of the complaint moved by

the petitioner and the investigation has been conducted fairly. He further contends that notices have been issued to Neena Sharma, Sharad Sharma, Rattan Lal (Lamberdar) and petitioner Nirmala Devi, Shashi Bhushan, Hawa Singh, Ex-Sarpanch and they have been directed to join the investigation in the present case. The learned State counsel has assured the Court that the matter shall be investigated fairly and impartially after taking into account the stand taken by the petitioner as well as the private respondents. He has further assured the Court that in case any complaint is moved with regard to the threat to life and liberty of the petitioner or any other person, the same shall be looked into and appropriate action shall be taken, in accordance with law.

In view of the assurance made by the learned State counsel, this Court does not deem it appropriate to pass any further orders and the petition is, accordingly, disposed off.
