Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in criminal case having FIR No.313 dated 1.12.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 506, 34 IPC at Police Station Ambala Sadar, District Ambala.

2. The petitioners were granted interim bail with direction to join investigation vide detailed order dated 22.12.2022 passed by this Court.

3. Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners apprised the Court that in compliance of the said order, the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police.

4. Counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant while resisting the present petition, submits that the petitioner got admitted students in

B.Sc. Nursing course in their college without getting approval of the

University.

5. State counsel on instructions from SI Sultan Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioners and further submits that the petitioners are not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 22.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
