Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.169 dated 3.10.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 120-B IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Travel professionals (Regulation) Act at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate.

On the last date of hearing, Coordinate Bench of this Court while taking into consideration the fact that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties vide compromise deed Annexure P-3 dated 30.11.2022, granted interim bail and gave directions to the petitioner to join the investigation.

Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the previous order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and also reiterated that the dispute between the parties has been settled vide

compromise deed Annexure P-3 and that the parties are going to file the petition seeking quashing of the FIR on the basis of the aforesaid compromise.

State counsel on instructions from SI Baljinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.12.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
