1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 28.07.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-6086-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 28.07.2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 13.12.2023 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 13.12.2023 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
