The prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.209 dated 21.11.2022 under Sections 188, 336 IPC (Section 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act added later on), registered at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar (Rural).

Status report by way of affidavit of Manmohan Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar-Rural, on behalf of respondent-State, already filed in the Registry. The same is taken on record.

In para 7 of the status report, it has been mentioned that the present petitioner was holding two toy pistols in his both hands and he was firing from these toy pistols while filling potassium therein and was getting his photographs clicked.

Vide order dated 23.12.2022, the petitioner was granted the interim protection.

Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 23.12.2022, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In view of version of the prosecution that the pistols were toy guns and the petitioner has already joined the investigation, the interim order dated 23.12.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made ***absolute***. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
