Prayer in the present petition is for quashing the FIR No.38 dated 04.04.2019, under Sections 307, 324, 341, 506, 148, 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Commissionerate Jalandhar as well as subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 24.11.2022.

Status report by way of affidavit of Mr. Nirmal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Jalandhar, filed on behalf of learned State counsel, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted before this Court that the petitioner is not even identified in this case. She has submitted that though there are four accused, however, the case of the petitioner is different from rest of the accused.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has approached this Court on the basis of partial compromise. He, on

instructions, has further submitted that in all, there are four accused and challan has been presented against one of the accused. However, regarding the petitioner and the other co-accused, investigation is yet to be completed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedies before the trial Court as in accordance with law.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
