The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.298 dated 06.10.2021 under Sections 419/420/120-B IPC and Sections 66-C, 66-D of Information Technology (Amendment) Act, 2008 (Section 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sector 13/17 Panipat, District Panipat.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

A status report/short reply dated 28.09.2023 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from Inspector

Mohinder Pal submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in

terms of the order dated 18.08.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.08.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
