Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order of compulsory retirement of the petitioner has already been set-aside but the petitioner is not being given benefit on the ground that a fresh order is to be passed after obtaining the concurrence of the Subordinate Services Selection Board as well as that review petition is pending. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no decision is being taken by the respondents after passing of the order dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-6) by the appellate authority and the petitioner is being prejudiced as neither the petitioner is being allowed to join the duties nor being paid the retiral benefits.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that any order which is to be passed in terms of the order dated 30.09.2022 (Annexure P-6) or as per review petition, the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from today and the same will be informed to the petitioner and any benefit for which the petitioner becomes entitled for keeping in view the order which is to be passed, the same will also be released within a further period of four weeks.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the said statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage.

6. Ordered accordingly.
