By way of this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C, petitioner has prayed for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.937 dated 16.11.2022 registered under Section 20-B of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station City Yamunanagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Pursuant to the order dated 23.02.2023, status report is filed by the respondent in the form of affidavit of Shri Kanwaljeet Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar as per which except for the disclosure statement of co-accused and that of her own, no incriminating material has been found against the petitioner. However, it is pointed out that petitioner is involved in one more case.

Having regard to the fact that petitioner has already joined the investigation and there is no incriminating material against her except her own disclosure statement and the disclosure statement of the co-accused, the order dated 04.01.2023 whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail is hereby made absolute in the above-said FIR No.937.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation, if and so required by the Investigating Officer.
