The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, as they apprehend imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.4 to 6.

Further prayer was made in the petition to register the FIR against respondents No.4 to 6, who had trespassed in the house of the petitioner and caused her several injuries, including fractures.

A status report by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Ludhiana has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Maninder Bedi, Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Ludhiana submits that one FIR

No.88, dated 12.05.2023, under Sections 323, 325, 451,34 IPC, Police Station Salem Tabri, Ludhiana has been registered against the persons, who had attacked the present petitioner and caused her injuries.

The Assistant Commissioner of Police, North, Ludhiana has further assured the Court that the said case shall be investigated fairly and impartially. He has further assured the Court that in case any complaint is received with regard to the threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner, appropriate action shall be taken in accordance with law.

In view of the assurance given by official respondents, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly disposed off.
