Inter alia contends that in spite of the application under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002, having been filed on 21.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) before the concerned District Magistrate, the same is still pending adjudication.

Short prayer in the instant writ petition is for such application to be dealt with in accordance with law as also expeditiously.

Since an advance copy of the writ petition already stood served upon the State of Haryana, Mr. Sharan Sethi, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has entered appearance.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Mr. Nishant Yadav, District Magistrate, Gurugram makes a statement that the application filed by the petitioner/Bank under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 would be dealt with by the concerned District Magistrate in

accordance with law and a final order would be passed within a period of four weeks from today.

Writ petition is disposed of.
