This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for issuing time bound directions to respondent No.1 to decide the case filed by the petitioner against the order dated 01.10.2015 bearing No.31 of 2016 dated 18.07.2016.

On 22.12.2022, Coordinate Bench of this Court has passed the following order:-

“It is submitted that Case No.31 dated 18.07.2016 has still not been decided. Thus, a direction may be issued to respondent No.1 to decide the same within a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service. She seeks time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 09.01.2023.”

Learned State counsel has submitted that the post of Financial Commissioner is lying vacant and as soon as the new incumbent is appointed, the case No.31 of 2016 dated 18.07.2016 will be disposed of within a period of six weeks.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Financial Commissioner (Revenue) Haryana, to decide the judicial Case No.31 of 2016, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of six weeks from the date the new incumbent assumes office.
