Reply by way of an affidavit of Shamsher Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Punhana, District Nuh has been filed by learned State counsel on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 and same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.

Relevant paragraph 3 of the said reply says as under:

“3 That in compliance of the order dated 23.12.2023, it is respectfully submitted that after receiving the present Petition, an enquiry has been conducted by the enquiry officer and statements of the petitioners no. 1 & 2 are recorded in which they have categorically stated that they have contended that presently they are living at their house happily. They have no apprehending danger from the private respondents and are on visiting terms to the house of the private respondents. The petitioners have further contended that the parents and brother of the petitioner no. 2 have accepted their marriage with open heart and they have also started going and meeting the private respondents. The petitioners have also specifically contended that they have no apprehending danger from the private respondents. They have also contended that

they do not require police protection. The statements of petitioner no. 1 & 2 are annexed as Annexure R-1 & R-2.”

In view of the stand taken by official respondents in their said reply, learned counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition.

Present petition stands disposed of being not pressed.
