The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.0221 dated 5.12.2022 under Sections 409, 511, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Amargarh, Police District Malerkotla, District Sangrur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 13.04.2023 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Gur Iqbal Singh, Deputy Supdt. Of Police, Sub Division Amargarh, District Malerkotla in court today which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms

of orders dated 13.04.2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 13.04.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
