JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondents to consider claim of the petitioner for the post of Constable which is lying vacant.
2. The petitioner pursuant to advertisement No.1/2016 applied for the post of Constable. The petitioner figured at Serial No.16 of the waiting list. The respondent on account of vacancies called candidates at Serial Nos.1 to 15 in the waiting list. One candidate out of aforesaid 15 candidates has refused to join, thus, one seat is still lying vacant. The petitioner filed representation dated 25.03.2023 (Annexure P-3) followed by another representation dated 06.04.2023 (Annexure P-4) praying the respondents to consider his claim for the vacant post.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, learned State counsel, who on advance notice is present in Court on behalf of the respondents, assures the Court that representations of the petitioner would be considered and disposed of within two months from today.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to aforesaid arrangement.
5. In the wake of statements of learned counsels for the parties, the present petition stands disposed of.
