The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.117 dated 17.10.2022 under Sections 166, 167, 419, 420, 465, 466, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Cantt. Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, Punjab.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 22.12.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Mr. Babandeep Singh Assitant Commissioner of Police, Cantonment V, Jalandhar, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated

22.12.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 22.12.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
