In pursuance of the order dated 07.02.2023, the counsel for the petitioner asserts that the petitioner reached the police station at 10.00 A.M., 14.02.2023, the date and time as stipulated by this Court but the Investigating Officer was not available and hence investigation could not be joined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has raised serious apprehension at the hands of the Investigating Officer who is intentionally and deliberately not facilitating the joining in the investigation of the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that due to visit of Home Minister, the Investigating Officer could not come present in the police station on 14.02.2023 but does not have any satisfactory explanation as to why on 15.02.2023 on petitioner's offer after visiting to the police station for joining the investigation was not accepted.

Prima facie despite three opportunities, the conduct of the Investigating Officer is also not trustworthy, therefore, he is directed to come present in Court on the next date of hearing alongwith the status report after

the petitioner joins the investigation again on 20.02.2023 at 10.00 A.M.

Adjourned to 28.02.2023.

Interim order to continue till the next date of hearing.
