This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India to issue an order/direction/writ in the nature of mandamus to the respondents to take necessary action against the violators of the illegal parking on the passage/footpath, which leads to village Majri (near Sector-2), Panchkula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that violation had taken place even after the reply dated 14.09.2022 (Annexure P-5) given by the Deputy Commissioner, Panchkula stating that if any illegal parking is found, the legal action would be taken against wrongdoer as per law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to move a complaint before the

competent authority under giving specific details of the cars/scooters and other vehicles, who have illegally parked their vehicles.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
