The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the Show Cause Notice dated 08.05.2023 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner was called upon to explain the position with documentary proofs within two days pertaining to original ITI Certificate bearing Roll No.3185502 dated 02.01.2006 along with original Provisional Certificate dated 04.01.2006. The petitioner was further given an opportunity to explain the position within 15 days from the receipt of that communication as to why disciplinary action may not be initiated against him.

Though, it is the positive stand taken by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he has duly replied to the said show cause notice i.e., Annexure P-3 dated Nil but the copy of the original reply is not readily available with him and asserts that the issuance of Show Cause Notice dated 08.05.2023, is arbitrary and unwarranted.

It is an admitted position that no final decision has been taken so far by

Nil, as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner., hence, approaching this Court to invoke the jurisdiction under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is premature and in haste.

At this stage, after arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to pursue the said relief with the respondent-Department in accordance with law.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
