This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned order / notice dated 31.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent no.3 with all the consequential proceedings whereby the notice has been issued for retiring the petitioner compulsorily from the government service on attaining the age of 55 years w.e.f. 04.12.2023.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the present writ petition is premature inasmuch as no final decision with respect to compulsory retirement has been taken and only a notice has been issued to the petitioner to show as to why he should not be compulsorily retired. It is further submitted that the petitioner has already filed reply to the said show cause notice dated 31.08.2023 and the said reply would be taken into consideration before passing the final order in case no such order has already been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no final order has been passed and has further submitted that present petition be disposed of, at this stage and the State be bound by the statement made before this Court.

Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of at this stage. The State would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
