Present writ petition has been filed for directing the respondents to construct and operate the Boosting Station (Mini Water Box) as per the resolution of Gram Panchayat, layout plan, estimate and other all formalities approved and duly sanctioned by respondent No.6 and other higher officials at site Khasra Nos.863 (Empty Plot 18 Marla Land of Gram Panchayat) instead of unauthorized unapproved and without sanctioned site at khasra No.1428 (Common Main Chowk and Street 24' wide 15.7 Marla) at village Baijalpur, District Fatehabad. Further prayer has been made for staying the construction and operation of said Boosting Station (Mini Water Works).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the petitioner filed a civil suit, however, the same was withdrawn with liberty to approach the appropriate authority by filing the representation for

the redressal of his grievance. He submits that the petitioner be granted the liberty to file his representation before respondent No.6 i.e. Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, District Fatehabad and he be directed to decide the same after hearing the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Upasna Dhawan, AAG, Haryana appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

After hearing both the parties and perusing the record, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file his appropriate representation before respondent No.6 as prayed for within a period of 07 days from today. If any such representation is filed by the petitioner within the stipulated period, then respondent No.6 i.e. Executive Engineer, Public Health Engineering Division, District Fatehabad is directed to hear the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of its filing.
