1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.0176 dated 15.11.2022 registered under Sections 406, 420, 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Nakodar Sadar, District Jalandhar.

2. Counsel for the petitioners submits that both the petitioners have joined investigation with the police in compliance of previous order and further now the matter has been compromised between the parties and compromise deed is Annexure P-13 and in furtherance of the said compromise, daughter of petitioner has sent the concerned documents, on the basis of which now the son of the complainant has applied for work visa in order get immigration of Canada.

3. State counsel on instructions from ASI Zorawar Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by counsel for the petitioner and submits that the petitioners are not required by police for further investigation or for custodial interrogation. State counsel also apprised that original compromise deed is available on the police record.

4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby allowed and order dated 23.12.2022 is hereby made absolute. The petitioner should abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
