1. This is the second petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.127 dated 07.05.2021, registered under Sections 302 and 328 IPC, at Police Station Gadpuri, Palwal, District Palwal.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that out of total 14 prosecution witnesses, 12 witnesses have been examined and the remaining two witnesses have even been called for today and the petitioner is the sole accused in the case of murder of his wife.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2021 and has prayed that he would not press the present petition, at this stage, in case the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
5. The trial Court is directed to expeditiously conclude the trial.
