1. The petitioner herein is the wife of the respondent. On account of marital discord between the parties, proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, are pending before the Family Court. An application filed by the petitioner under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, for grant of maintenance *pendente lite*, has been dismissed by the trial Court on the ground that the petitioner has failed to furnish complete information including her Income Tax record.
2. From the reading of the impugned order, it is evident that the parties belong to affluent strata of the society. It has been projected that the petitioner-wife is one of the Director in M/s Anant Processions Pvt. Ltd., Ludhiana, having turn-over in crores.
3. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh application after giving complete particulars to enable the Court to adjudicate the matter.
4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
