JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner, through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., is seeking quashing of order dated 07.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) whereby JMIC, Jalandhar has declared the petitioner as proclaimed offender in FIR No.105 dated 01.06.2014 under Sections 376 366A and 363 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Ms. Sakshi Mittal, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and filed her power of attorney. The same is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the parties have compromised the matter and settled their all disputes. The petitioner was declared proclaimed person in FIR No.105 dated 01.06.2014 under

Sections 376 366A and 363 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar. The said FIR stands quashed vide order dated 08.05.2023 passed by this Court in CRM-M-11660-2023.

4. Learned State counsel on instruction from Investigating Officer and counsel for respondents No.2 and 3 submitted that they have no objection if PO proceeding in view of quashing of main FIR are set aside.

5. In view of the fact that FIR No.105 dated 01.06.2014 under Sections 376 366A and 363 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar, stands quashed, the present petition deserves to be allowed and accordingly allowed.

6. Order dated 07.02.2015 (Annexure P-1) whereby JMIC, Jalandhar has declared the petitioner as proclaimed offender in FIR No.105 dated 01.06.2014 under Sections 376 366A and 363 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
