Petitioner has approached this Court praying for issuance of directions to learned trial Court for speedy and expeditious disposal of the trial in FIR No.150 dated 11.04.2017, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 379, 392, 394, 452, 506 of IPC (later on offences under Sections 379, 392, 394 of IPC were deleted), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Rohtak and to conduct the same in a time bound manner.

Status report filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Mahesh Kumar, HPS, DSP, Rohtak is taken on record.

Vide order dated 08.02.2023, the report from the trial Court was sought which has been sent by the Presiding Officer. On perusal of the report, it has been found that the application under Section 319 Cr.P.C. was filed by the complainant for summoning the additional accused and due to the non-appearance of the accused namely, Rajesh and Sachin, the trial is delayed. It has been mentioned that warrants of arrest have been issued for securing the presence of the accused persons.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that 08 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

After perusing the report, the present petition is disposed of with request to the learned trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably within six months from today.
